The Baltic Sea region is one of the most important funding regions of the EU. Since 2009 it is also the first area for which a macro-regional EU strategy has been adopted, through the Baltic Sea Region Program (EUSBSR). With the implementation of the EU Baltic Sea strategy, the region has done a lot to improve its competitiveness, the ecological condition of the Baltic Sea and the social cohesion to further improve cohesion of its peoples.

Four of the key EU funding programs that support projects for economic and scientific cooperation as well as the social cohesion of the region will present their programmes to the interested public on March 9th and 10th 2022 in Rostock. Next to the host city of Rostock, some of the leading cross-border networks for further municipal cooperation in the Baltic Sea region, the Union of Baltic Cities and the European Integration Center, will also present their initiatives and strategies for enhancing in-depth, cross-border cooperation.
